



EMERGENCY EVACUATION

For RESIDENTS

- Remain Calm Do not panic
- Call 911 from a safe location and state your location and nature of emergency
- Check to see if door is hot with backside of hand before exiting
- Take your key incase you need to return to your unit
- If smoke is present stay low to the floor
- Never go up in a building
- Do not use elevators
- If not able to walk down the stairs, remain at the landing in the stairway and emergency personnel will assist you as soon as possible. After everyone has exited out and are clear, enter the stairway to stage in place.







- Place a wet towel underneath door/ Fill bathtub and sink with water incase you need it
 - Try to get attention from window(Do not break window)

(20 not break timestr)

- When you can get out safely:
 - Immediately leave the building using the nearest exit
 - Do not re-enter building until you receive further instruction from emergency personnel
 - Meet in designated assembly area

PRE-EVACUATION

- Keep necessary items in a central location that is quickly accessible
 - Medications
 - Identification/Driver's license
 - Insurance cards



- Contact information
- Emergency Kit i.e. flashlight, first aid, batteries, bottled water
