COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS AND RESIDENTS' MEETINGS

Last March the governor issued a twoweek stay-at-home order to slow the spread of COVID-19. That order and subsequent Health Orders have prohibited in-person gatherings.

The SRAB has subscribed to Zoom for on-line meetings. Zoom is an internet conference platform where people can see, talk, and share with each other.) This has worked well. assist you with the application process will be listed on the SERA Program website.

- Both landlords and renters can apply.
- Households that previously applied for and/or received rental assistance through the SERA Program are eligible to apply again.
